Clover Crate Descriptions

Clinton County

K-3rd Grade Clover Crates

Intro to Coding: Youth will be introduced to basic coding concepts through off-screen activities, virtual robot simulator, and block-based coding activities. Registration for this Clover Crate includes access to an online program for 30 days. *Pick up June 8*

Art Explosion: This Clover Crate will help youth learn about foundational art elements including line, shape, color, form, and texture. *Pick up June 15*

Agriculture Everywhere: A partnership with Clinton County Farm Bureau, this Clover Crate teaches about how agriculture affects us every day with hands-on activities. An included sweet treat makes this fun for the whole family. *Pick up June 22.*

4-6th Grade Clover Crates

The Science of Magic: The goal of this Clover Crate is to encourage youth to observe carefully and investigate interesting physical science phenomena while learning to perform illusions. Get ready for a magic show performance after youth spend time practicing. Science concepts taught in a fun way. *Pick up June 8*

Spa Retreat: Youth will make homemade body products and learn different relaxation techniques to simulate a day at the spa! Most materials provided, may need to purchase additional materials to complete some activities or make larger batches. *Pick up June 15*

Crime Scene Investigation: Youth will strengthen their observation skills while examining crime scenes. Through close observation, they will distinguish clues that appear to be the same. The youth will also spent time strengthening their measuring skills. This will be a fun to include family members! *Pick up June 22.*
