Content



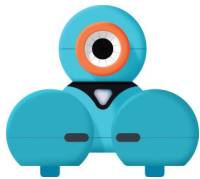

Learn how you can help plants grow and take home tools you can use to produce your own food, prepare new recipes to try new foods, and active lessons to get our heart pumping.



Fizz, Bubble, Goo: Come and explore the wonders of science by creating amazing chemistry experiments with everyday materials to watch them fizz, bubble, and goo. Youth will learn about matter and its three states, make slime, and observe chemical and physical changes before their very eyes!
