**Explore the world with us from 10:00 a.m. to Noon
on Saturdays this summer!**

- May 31** Tour **Blue Hyll Dairy** and see where the milk you drink comes from. Pet the calves and see the milking operation. They milk 1,200 cows three times a day! *T-shirts will be distributed at this event and all events thereafter.*
- June 7** Find out what happens to all the trash that you throw away as we tour the **Clinton County Solid Waste Agency**. Learn about the life cycle of a landfill and how recycling does not end at the curb. Closed-toe shoes required.
- June 21** **Fulton Windmill Cultural Center / delmigrant** - This year's theme "Wheels Around The World" focuses on all the "wheels" it takes to travel around the world! Also, an interactive true story, "Mailing May", about a little girl who was shipped by train to visit her grandmother. Event includes a tour of the windmill! REMINDER: The North Bridge will be closed due to construction at this time. Please use the South Bridge to Fulton.
- June 28** **The Sawmill Museum** is where local history comes to life! Explore our new exhibits, including the water table, and play like a lumberjack in our 1888 lumber camp. Create a craft to take home, and learn how to play with old-time games. From 10:30 – 11:30 LyondellBasell will be presenting Special Science Based Experiments. You won't want to miss the excitement!!
- July 5** Enjoy a baseball game with the **Clinton LumberKings** at the ballpark, with special recognition of EnviroKids at 6:00 p.m. Check-in starts at 5:30 p.m. (Admission free for EnviroKids only.)
- July 12** Explore the great outdoors at the **Izaak Walton League**. Experience fun in the outdoors, canoeing, fishing, and a hayride on the prairie and the wetlands. There will also be a demonstration on archery and firearms (*no live ammunition*). Lunch will be served. Note: Wear shoes that fully cover the feet (no flip-flops or sandals).
- July 26** "Fun With The Sun" at the **Felix Adler Children's Discovery Center!** Use sun power to create art and cook your own hot dog!
- Aug 2** Ride on the Blue Heron pontoon boat, pond study, stand-up paddle boards, kayaks, and canoes for families at the **Mississippi River Eco Tourism Center** (Rock Creek Marina). Complete the fun with yummy S'mores. Adults are welcome to accompany children with water activities.
