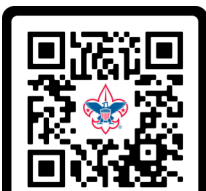

Scouts meet regularly in small groups to work on projects. Uniforms, badges, games, sports, fun!



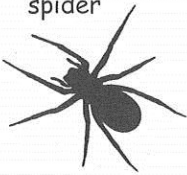
Webelos Scouting (4th & 5th Grades)

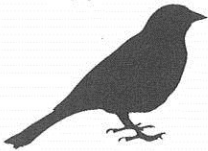

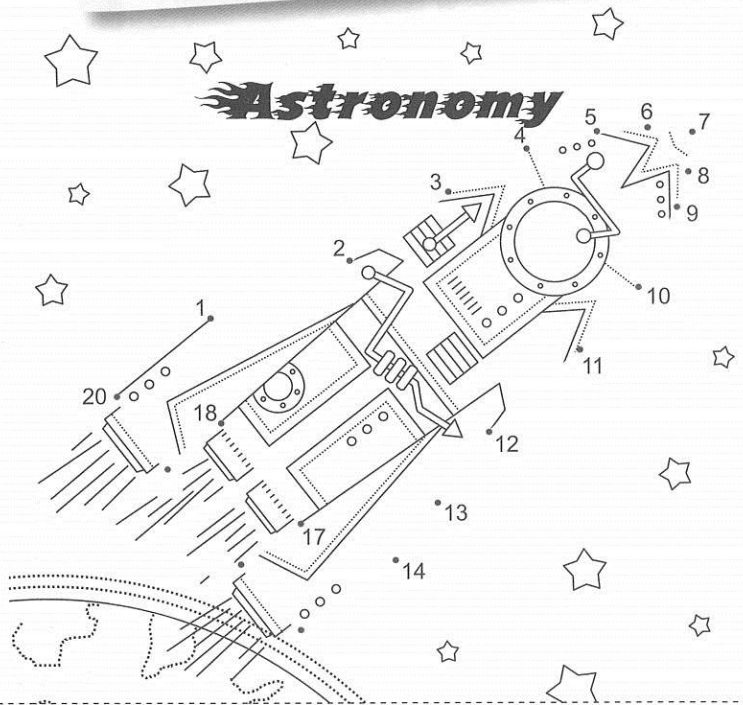
